

MIT READ-ME FILE

- 1. Certification is NOT revision specific.** Any currently certified IPC-A-600 CIT can conduct CIS training on **any** 600 revision.
- 2. START BY READING THE MIT SURVIVAL GUIDE!**
3. Both IPC-A-600 initial certification and recertification courses use the same CIT open book exam and review quizzes.
4. The CIT and CIS training reports have been updated and formatted for automated data extraction into our database. It must be submitted as in a file format compatible with commonly used word processor software such as .doc or .rtf. **UNLESS OTHERWISE ADVISED BY IPC, DO NOT SUBMIT THE FILE AS A PDF. DO NOT UNLOCK OR MODIFY THE REPORT FILES IN ANY WAY.**
5. **PLEASE** submit training reports as quickly as possible. Often the CITs you certify will contact IPC customer service within one or two days after completion of training to order CIS certificates. They cannot purchase the certificates until we receive your report of their training.
6. Early in 2008 IPC introduced new logos. This MIT CD has a folder with all Logos for all certification programs. The logos are provided in many file format types suitable for printing, web posting, e-mail signature files, etc. When you reprint your business cards, update your web site, etc., please use the new logos. The CD for CITs to train CIS will only have the logo files for the IPC-A-600 program.
