



Chemical Management & Safety Capacity Building Training **Beta Testing Opportunity**

The Clean Electronics Production Network (CEPN) is seeking electronics brands and suppliers to participate in free (no cost) in-person beta testing chemical safety training for workers and management in electronics manufacturing facilities in Vietnam and Malaysia. Beta testing of digital and webinar (live or recorded) is also an available option as part of the training suite. The trainings will be available in English, Malay, and Vietnamese.

Development of this training has been funded by the <u>Initiative for Global Solidarity</u>, a program of the <u>Deutsche</u> Gesellschaft für internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH.

Based on the building blocks of the **Toward Zero Exposure** program, the training will disseminate best practices in process chemical management, reduce worker exposures to hazardous chemicals and strengthen worker safety and engagement.

There are 5 modules for workers, 2 modules for managers as well as a manager toolkit for creating facility specific chemical management training - and is available as:
